

THINGS TO DO IN GRAPEVINE TEXAS

Explore the heart of Grapevine, the beautifully preserved Historic Main Street, which is lined with more than 80-locally owned restaurants, boutiques, jewelry stores, winery tasting rooms and <u>art galleries</u>. Take a ride on the <u>Grapevine Vintage Railroad</u>, shop until you drop at <u>Grapevine Mills mall</u>, enjoy a performance at the <u>Grapevine Opry Show</u> or learn more about the history of Grapevine at <u>Nash Farm</u>. Outdoor enthusiasts can explore one of the city's many hiking trails, picnic in a neighborhood park or ride a Segway at Lake Grapevine and shop at Bass Pro Shops Outdoor World, a 200,000-square-foot mega-store dedicated to the great outdoors.

The Grapevine Vintage Railroad offers excursions during most of the year: **<u>Round Trip</u>** <u>Grapevine to the Historic Stockyards</u>

The train to the Stockyards operates Saturday and Sunday most weekends throughout the year, including Memorial Day to Labor Day. The train departs Grapevine at 1 p.m. and arrives in the Stockyards at approximately 2:30 p.m. The return trip departs the Stockyards at 4:15 p.m. and arrives in Grapevine at approximately 5:45 p.m.
